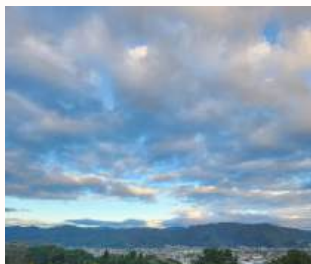

An ambassador is a representative of a specified activity or country. It comes from the Latin word “ambactus” which means servant (Oxford Languages)
